### **NOTIFICATION OF ROUTINE MAINTENANCE WORKS (SLIP ROADS AND LAYBYS)**

#### **A14 Westbound, closure between junctions 2 and 1.**

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out overnight road works on the A14 westbound, between A14 junctions 2 (A508 Maidwell/Kelmarsh) and 1 (Welford).

By carrying out routine maintenance work now, we can reduce the need for emergency closures and / or more comprehensive packages of work which necessitate longer closures.

#### **When will the work take place?**

This work will start on Sunday, **2 June 2019** and will be complete by Monday, **3 June 2019**.

Please note that all our planned roadworks are subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

#### **How will the work affect traffic?**

To minimise inconvenience and disruption to the travelling public, we will carry out the work **overnight from 9pm to 5am**. To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we will need to fully close the carriageway between A14 junctions 1 and 2 while we work on it.

While the road is closed, we will put in place fully signed diversion routes which have been agreed with the local authority. The main diversion route will take traffic southbound from A14 junction 2 via the A508 Harborough Road towards Northampton, then traffic will travel northbound on the A5199 before re-joining the A14 at junction 1.

We politely ask all heavy vehicles to follow the diversion route which will help minimise the overnight disturbance experienced by communities in the surrounding area.

We apologise for any inconvenience caused during delivery. We will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
